

# Proposed Tax Levies for the 2024 November General Election

## Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement and Increase) Guernsey County Countryview Assisted Living Center

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A replacement of 1 mill of an existing levy and an increase of 0.5 mills to constitute a tax for the benefit of Guernsey County Countryview Assisted Living Center for the purpose of maintaining and operating the Countryview Assisted Living Center, formerly known as the Guernsey County Home that the county auditor estimates will collect \$1,750,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1.5 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$53 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**

## Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) Guernsey County Mental Health & Recovery Services Board

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Guernsey County Mental Health & Recovery Services Board for the purpose of the operation of alcohol, and drug addiction programs and mental health programs that the county auditor estimates will collect \$915,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$24 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 10 years, **commencing in 2024, first due in calendar year 2025.**

## Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal and Increase) Guernsey County Senior Citizens Center, Inc. and the Robert T. Secrest Senior Center

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of 1.5 mills and an increase of 0.3 mills for each \$1 of taxable value to constitute a tax for the benefit of Guernsey County for the purpose of providing senior services by the Guernsey County Senior Citizens Center, Inc. and the Robert T. Secrest Senior Center that the county auditor estimates will collect \$1,944,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1.8 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$58 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**

## Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) Fairview Village

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Fairview Village for the purpose of current expenses that the county auditor estimates will collect \$2,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 4.7 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$87 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**

## Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) Lore City Village

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Lore City Village for the purpose of fire protection that the county auditor estimates will collect \$9,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 3 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$95 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2024, first due in calendar year 2025.**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**  
**Old Washington Village**

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Old Washington Village for the purpose of current expenses that the county auditor estimates will collect \$8,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 4 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$46 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement)**  
**Pleasant City Village**

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A replacement of a tax for the benefit of Pleasant City Village for the purpose of current expenses that the county auditor estimates will collect \$8,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 2 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$70 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**  
**Quaker City Village**

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Quaker City Village for the purpose of street improvement and maintenance that the county auditor estimates will collect \$7,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1.5 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$50 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**  
**Senecaville Village**

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Senecaville Village for the purpose of street improvement and maintenance that the county auditor estimates will collect \$15,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 3.5 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$114 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**  
**Adams Township**

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Adams Township for the purpose of providing funds for purchasing and maintaining fire apparatus and appliances and for payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer firemen or fire fighting companies to operate the same and/or provide fire protection that the county auditor estimates will collect \$127,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 2.5 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$78 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**  
**Center Township (Including a portion of Lore City Village)**

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Center Township (including a portion of Lore City Village) for the purpose of road resurfacing, repair and maintenance, including dust control that the county auditor estimates will collect \$46,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$23 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**  
**Liberty Township**

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Liberty Township for the purpose of current expenses that the county auditor estimates will collect \$21,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$23 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**  
**Liberty Township**

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Liberty Township for the purpose of fire protection that the county auditor estimates will collect \$11,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 0.5 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$12 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**  
**Oxford Township (Including Fairview Village)**

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Oxford Township (including Fairview Village) for the purpose of fire protection that the county auditor estimates will collect \$27,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$17 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**  
**Oxford Township (Excluding Fairview Village)**

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Oxford Township (excluding Fairview Village) for the purpose of cemetery maintenance that the county auditor estimates will collect \$27,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$17 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal)**  
**Spencer Township (Excluding Cumberland Village)**

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A renewal of a tax for the benefit of Spencer Township (excluding Cumberland Village) for the purpose of fire protection that the county auditor estimates will collect \$12,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding .5 mill for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$11 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, commencing in 2025, **first due in calendar year 2026.**

**Proposed Tax Levy (Replacement and Increase)**  
**Valley Township (Including Pleasant City Village)**

**A majority affirmative vote is necessary for passage.**

A replacement of 1 mill of an existing levy and an increase of 0.5 mill to constitute a tax for the benefit of Valley Township (including Pleasant City Village) for the purpose of maintaining and operating cemeteries that the county auditor estimates will collect \$98,000 annually, at a rate not exceeding 1.5 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$53 for each \$100,000 of the county auditor's appraised value, for 5 years, **commencing in 2025, first due in calendar year 2026.**
